What impact might this have on Harry's life?

- Less time to meet new **friends**
- Less time to do fun new things like **joining clubs** and **going on trips**
- More **homework** to catch up on missed lessons
- Less **qualifications** when he leaves school
(**17 missed school days** a year = GCSE grade **DROP**)
- Less **choice** of what job he would like to do – you need to have qualifications to do most jobs
- Less earnings
- Less **money** to spend on fun things like holidays and cars



Qualifications = £'s

Students leaving with 5 - 9's at GCSE, over a lifetime, will earn **£350,000** more than those leaving with 5 - 4's

6. Create a learning environment

Our people are punctual and aspirational in lessons and around school. They never make excuses and do as instructed the first time, without question.

How well did year 11 do last year?

English, Maths and Science	Grades 9 - 8	Grades 9 - 4	Grades 9 - 1
93% + Attendance	25%	85%	100%
80% - Attendance	0%	36%	87%

- Every single student with 93% + attendance, left with GCSE's in English, Maths and Science.
- 25% - A QUARTER achieved a 9-8.
- Not one student with attendance less than 80% got a grade 6 or above!
- Only 36% of students with an attendance of 80% - left with the MINIMUM requirement.

You are in control
